

ALBION PARK SHOW 18 JANUARY 2020 DEMOLITION DERBY DEMONSTRATION

It's almost Derby time again and just a quick note to highlight some important changes.

Firstly the derby is a demonstration event to promote local businesses to your local community and at the same time have fun. As we all know the public liability debate keeps making it harder to run events of this nature and your co-operation is required to ensure that we can continue to provide advertising for your sponsors.

Due to changes in all show society public liabilities policies all competitors / exhibitors are required to sign waiver forms prior to entering any event. These will be available to sign at the showground on the Saturday and once you have signed you will be issued with an arm band that must be worn at all times. No arm band - no entry to the event. This also changes the format of the parade lap; we can no longer allow any other person to ride within the derby car other than the driver.

Our Demolition Derby will be conducted under the Rules & Regulations approved by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW. All drivers will be required at the Tennis Court compound from 4.00pm as there is a strong possibility that events may run early.

Entry fees – Please pay your entry fees at the show office on the showground during the week prior to the show. The office will be open from 9.00am till 5.00pm. starting from Monday 13 January. When you pay your fees you will receive your entry tickets. A receipt for your fees and your entry form are to be presented to the co-ordinating person on Friday 17 January when you drop off the car.
