The usual commission will be charged by the agents and then donated to the Show Society. There will be a fee for cartage to the abattoir. All entries will be for unreserved sale and exhibitors cannot bid on their own entries. All exhibits to have appropriate H.G.P. certification. Entries will be inspected by stewards and may be rejected if not of suitable standard and temperament. Entries to be penned by 11:00 am for numbering and weighing. Entries will be slaughtered on the Monday following the Show. Carcass can be inspected on the Tuesday following judging. Entries will be limited to 40 head on a first entry basis
